

Volunteer Opportunities

Garage Sale Committee:

This is a great donation opportunity to raise money through volunteer donations of garage sale goods in which the money raised can be donated back to the Tennis Booster Club. Because it is designated as a donation, it doesn't fall under the scrutiny of formal fundraisers for the year. It has proven to be a low key, fruitful way of generating funds. This is purely an organized donation event and does not fall within the 2 major fundraiser limit.

Scope: It will require someone to coordinate the dates for the River Place garage sales that occur 1- 2 times a year for each. It will also include communication to parents as well as drop off site and time, volunteer schedule and clean up.

Pavers Committee

This is a new fundraiser that is still in the early stages of development. It will provide parents an option to purchase pavers or bricks with their child's name and graduation date etc. to be placed on campus, in a location not yet designated to commemorate their attendance at Vandegrift High School. We are still waiting on approval but we wanted to have leadership in place so we can make this a timely fundraiser for our first graduating class. This is one of 2 major fundraisers that are within UIL fundraising guidelines.

Scope: This will require a chairperson and volunteers to communicate, market, create order forms and receive payments and act as a liaison to the designated paver company.

Tournament Fundraiser

This is slated to be a fall or spring fundraiser inviting adult tennis players in the community as well as coaches and some players from the district to compete during a one day tournament. The coach has conducted and participated in similar events and has a wealth of information on this event. This will require the students and multiple parent volunteers. This is one of 2 major fundraisers that are within the UIL fundraising guidelines

Scope: Volunteers will plan organize coordinate and market this event.

Viperpalooza Committee

This event is held in the spring and is a school wide fundraiser that reaches out to the elementary and middle schools as participants in a carnival/spring-fest type environment with games petting zoos, dunking booths etc. For the last 2 years we have sponsored an inflatable obstacle race course in which pre-purchased tickets pay for a run through the course. The school markets this event.

Scope: This will require Coach, Parent and Student volunteers to manage the course. The committee will be in charge of securing the inflatable course, it's placement at the event and coordinating times for student volunteers

Apparel

This person will coordinate all the apparel for any additional needs the team may have including events such as Viperpalooza, district, regionals, and or state specialty shirts. They will also be responsible for yard signs, car stickers, and any other spirit wear.

Scope: This person will be responsible for ordering, collecting and distributing purchases. In addition they will be communicating with the board and its committee chairs as well as the coaches on needs. They will be working with coach and board approved vendors.

Volunteer Opportunities Cont'd

Hospitality

This committee will be in charge of providing snacks within UIL guidelines and possibly spirit banners/signs for JV and Varsity tournaments primarily District Regional and State tournament.

Scope: These persons will communicate to the tennis parents, receive donations, coordinate donated snacks and distribute them prior to events. They may on occasion with District, Region, State or highly contested team play make spirit banners and signs for the bus or as the kids are leaving for out of town tournaments.

Liaison:

This person will be the parent contact for student social events such as season opening gatherings, Christmas get together and team building gatherings at players' houses making sure all events don't violate UIL guidelines. They will provide ideas or framework coordination that has been pre-established at the beginning of the year. Any parent interested in hosting any of these events will need to let this person know your interest, ideas or availability.

Banquet

This committee will plan coordinate and communicate the end of year Tennis Banquet.

Scope: The chairperson(s) and committee members will work with the coach planning and coordinate the date, location, food, decorations collecting the funds and the program format as well as a slide presentation.
